









We have got off to a great start since construction started in October last year. As of May 2017 we are now working on 7 of the 10 construction phases or 'reaches': E3, W4, E1, W6, W5, W3 and W2 (see map overleaf). We have also opened a visitor's centre where you can find out more.

At **Reach E3** the piling is almost complete. This will be finished when Network Rail's works are finished next year.

We have started work on the earth embankment, footpath and scour protection along the foreshore.



The steel sheet piling in **Reach W4** was completed in February 2017. Cladding of the wall with concrete and brickwork is almost complete.

The piling works at **Reach E1** were completed at the end of February 2017. We are nearly finished on the final stages in this reach.

The steel sheet pile wall has been installed and the concrete works have been completed in **Reach W6**. We are currently working on the embankment around the tidal pool and along the river bank north of the Sea Scout Hut. The section underneath the railway bridge will be completed when Network Rail's works are finished next year.

Tree clearance along **Reach W5** is nearly complete and the vegetation clearance is now underway.

Construction work in **Reach W3** started in May. We have started the steel sheet piling and concrete works, with work due to be completed before the end of 2017.

At **Reach W2** construction started in May and piling at the end of the slipway is complete. Work to raise the slipway, install the flood glass and concrete wall will be completed over the summer and autumn.

Downs Link diversion





Part of the Downs Link cycleway in Shoreham will be closed to the public during construction in E3. The closure is split into two phases (see below). Phase one is expected to be closed until early 2018, and phase two until autumn 2017. There is a temporary pedestrian route and signs have been provided along the route to give directions.



Emerald Quay Slipway Closure

The slipway at Emerald Quay is to be raised so that the top of the slipway is at flood defence level (see image from visualization below). This work started in May and is expected to be finished in August. The slipway will be closed for the duration of this work.

The visit includes a guided tour of the construction work and a workshop on flooding to tie in with the school curriculum.


